

Florida Palm Tree Precision

Palm trees are a beloved staple here in the state of Florida. Their beauty adds color and vibrance to any landscape. However, palm trees can encounter many nutrient deficiencies, as well as fungal pressure, and insect pressure. By using these products, you will have the best looking palms in the state.

Council-Oxford 12-4-12 1 Pound per 10 foot of height

Use 1 pound per 10 foot of height every 2-3 months for best results. This is a well balanced NPK fertilizer with slow release, as well as B, Mg, Mn, and Fe. All of which are nutrients that palm trees need.

Miller's ZMC Express Drench: 1 TSP / 5 GAL OR Foliar: 1/3 OZ / GAL or 1 Pound / Acre

When you see nutrient deficiencies in the fronds, Miller's ZMC express will provide EDTA micros such as B, Fe, Mn, and Mg. You will see a quicker response when using this because it is easily accepted by the plant.

ImidaPro 2SC 1.5 OZ / 100 GL or 0.015 OZ / GL

Palm trees will often see mealybug, scale, aphid, and white fly pressure. ImidaPro 2SC is a systemic insecticide designed to reduce these pressures. Apply every2-3 months to see best results.
