

"Mira Bay Mix"

Here in Apollo Beach, we get a lot of homeowners from the community "Mira Bay". So, this mix comes from them, and it is specifically for bermuda grass here in Central and South Florida.

Dylox 6.2 2-3 Pounds per 1,000 Sq. Ft. Every 3 Months

With bermuda grass, you often get grub worms and mole crickets, two soil inhabiting pests. Dylox will target these pests before they become a problem. Be sure to apply especially in April, and throughout the summer when these populations are at the their peak.

Sunniland 16-4-8 5 Pounds per 1,000 Sq. Ft. Every 6-8 Weeks

16-4-8 is a well-balanced NPK fertilizer that is readily available and designed to help give you a good green-up quickly.

Milorganite 15 Pounds per 1,000 Sq. Ft. every 6-8 weeks

Milorganite is a fantastic slow-release, organic fertilizer designed to slowly feed the lawn over time. Rotate this with 16-4-8, and you will be lush and green in no time.

Blindside Herbicide 0.23 OZ per GL as needed

Bermuda grass is known to see various weeds such as spurge, nutsedge, crabgrass, diamondflower, and much more. Blindside is a selective herbicide that will kill these unwanted weeds with harming your grass.

Barricade Pre-Emergent 2 LBS per 1,000 Sq. Ft. 4-5 times per year

If you want to stop the weeds from coming back once you have killed them, then you need Barricade. This prevents the weed seeds from germinating again. Start this in November/December, then again in January/February, then 2-3 more times after that.
