## Don't Forget the **Pre-Emergent!**

Pre-Emergent is an often forgotten step of lawn care. We often spend all this time killing weeds throughout the year, but forget to use a pre-emergent along with it. When we skip this step, the weeds continually germinate, and we get no relief. Pre-emergent's are not 100%, but once a good schedule is established, you will see less and less weeds year over year.

### Miller's Sustain 4 OZ - 1 PT per 100 GL

Sustain should be mixed with your herbicide sprays, especially pre-emergent sprays. This awesome product helps improve the contact, wetting, and adhesion of herbicides on the plant and soil surface(s).

### Rightline Dithiopyr 2EW 1-2 PTS per acre OR ½ OZ per 1,000

Dithiopyr controls a wide variety of broadleaf and grassy-type weeds in turf. Dithiopyr is especially excellent because it provides post emergent control of crabgrass up to the 5 leaf stage. Apply at least 4 times per year (November, December, February, April)

### Loyalty WDG 0.10 - 0.18 OZ / GL **\*NOT A Pre-Emergent\***

Use Loyalty WDG throughout the year as your selective, post emergent weed control to go alongside your pre-emergent. This proprietary formulation of Sulfentrazone is dry, meaning there is no carrier, so there is much lower burn potential.
